Opportunity for a DMDG intern committee position

A fundamental role of the DMDG organisation is the professional development of our members; this includes the provision of training courses but also the development of scientific communication skills. Many of our first experiences of presenting to the wider scientific community will have been during DMDG meetings, often starting with a poster leading to podium presentations. These initial experiences can lead to further group involvement such as participation as training course tutors, scientific sub-committee members and committee positions.

The DMDG committee wishes to promote the involvement of those early in their career within the DMDG organisation. To achieve this we are offering a 1-year DMDG intern committee position to begin at this year's Open Meeting at Robinson College, Cambridge, UK and to end after the 2018 Open Meeting. A typical profile would be someone with less than five years' experience in a DMPK related role with and no line management responsibility. During the year the nominated individual will gain valuable insight into the inner workings of the DMDG, participate in event management and be a key part in the organisation of our 2018 Open Meeting. Our aim is for them to attend all committee meetings and provide a voice for the newer DMPK generation helping us to define a more prominent role for this section of our membership. To this end the financial commitment required will be covered by the DMDG, but you would need permission from your member company to commit the time to the role. This would involve a 1 hour telecon meeting every 2 weeks, up to 4 face-to-face committee meetings and attendance at the 2017 and 2018 Open Meetings, in addition to time spent on assigned tasks.
